Charres received his formal education in the Oak Creek Scool District, in Oak Creek, Wisconsin. He went on to attend college at Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin where he double - majored in Communications and History. While at Marquette, Charles worked as a deejay on the radio as well as for special events. He was also the online editor for the Marquette Tribune newspaper, and he was the manager at the campus record store. Charles was an active member of the PHI BETA SIGMA FRATERNITY, INC (collegiate and graduate chapters); having been initiated on August 4, 1996.

Charles was baptised and accepted Christ at an early age. He attended church regularly with his mother. His faith was strong in the Lord. Charles was united in holy matrimony with Radiah Jah-nette Rupert on June 9, 2002 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in front of two hundred plus family and friends. They were best friends, co-workers, and the love of each other's lives.

Charles was employed by Assurant Health as an underwriter technician for nearly ten years. In his leisure, Charles enjoyed taking photos and making videos for family and friends. He was extremely tech savvy. Charles had a fascination with hip-hop and R&B music, and he particularly loved any song

by Lou Rawls. Charles was a very good dancer; he was "light on his feet" and relished in attempting to teach his non-dancing wife the latest dance moves. Charles had an infectious laugh and liked to have fun. Other interests include watching wrestling and movies on TV and traveling with Radiah.

Charles enjoyed giving back to the community. He was involved with the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life, where he served as co-chair for the planning committee. His team, Team Iron Man; which included Radiah and other family members and friends, was established as a tribute to his cousin Shaun Flanagan, who succumbed to cancer a few years ago. Charles was also a member of the Milwaukee Urban League Young Professionals.

In 2005, Charles and Radiah co-founded Urban Reviews, (<http://www.urbanreviewsonline.com>), a website that reviews African-American fiction. The website has received local and national attention in the African-American literary community.

Charles departed this life on February 17, 2013 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He was preceded in death by his grandparents, his aunt, Deborah Hubbert; and his cousin, Shaun Flanagan.
