



Mr. Alfred David Runyon Jr.

July 28, 1947 - June 21, 2013

Alfred David Runyon Jr. was born on July 28, 1947 to the union of Alfred David Runyon Sr. and Kitty Alberta Runyon in Clarksville, Tennessee.

Alfred, known to some people as “Sweet Al”, received his formal education at Riverside High School in Milwaukee, Wisconsin where he graduated with honors. He went on to attend the University of Wisconsin-Madison majoring in Pharmacy, but left and enlisted in the U.S. Marines Corp. on January 27, 1966. After completing boot camp training at Camp Pendleton in California, Alfred went on to Language Training School where he passed a course in Vietnamese. He then shipped out and headed for the Far East. He fought in the Vietnam War from September of 1966 – November of 1967 and was Honorably discharged February 1, 1968. During his tour of duty, Alfred was awarded two purple hearts and a medal of valor.

Alfred was baptized at the age of 9 at Greater Galilee Missionary Church, Milwaukee, Wisconsin where he accepted Christ as his Savior.

Alfred David Runyon Jr. departed this life on June 21, 2013. He was preceded in death by: parents, Alfred David Runyon Sr. and Kitty Alberta Runyon; grandparents, Robert Lee Runyon and Ethel Elizabeth Runyon; one sister, Carolyn Elaine Moore and several aunts and uncles.
