September 2, 1948 - May 10, 2016

Alzator Marion Fourston made her entrance into the world on September 2, 1948 to the union of Daniel Marion, Sr. and Ozella Marion Jenkins (nee Johnson) in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Affectionately nicknamed Corky, she received her formal education through Milwaukee Public Schools culminating in her graduating West Division High School.

Corky accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior and was baptized at Tabernacle Community Baptist Church, under the leadership of the Reverend Jewell L. Williams. Corky proudly served with pure devotion and an unflappable commitment to duty as a youth Sunday School teacher, a member of the Unlimited Usher Board and Young Mothers' Board. Corky was honored to be elected as the first National Vice President representing Wisconsin for the Youth Division of the United Ushers.
