Astrid came to Wisconsin to attend Carthage College in Kenosha, Wisconsin where she received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Administration and Marketing. She later obtained her MBA from Cardinal Stritch University in 2004.

Astrid married Victor Flowers on June 25, 1983 in Milwaukee, WI. They were happily married for 33 years. The couple have three children. In her free time, she enjoyed gardening, cooking, sewing, modeling, decorating, and spending time with her family. In the days leading up to her passing, she expressed how happy and blessed she felt to have such a loving family by her side. She fondly shared her appreciation for the attentiveness, patience, love and strength that her husband displayed as he cared for her during her illness.

Astrid was employed by State Farm Insurance Company for the past 30 years. She was a Property Claim Team Manager. She managed the property claims division of State Farm for the southern half of the state of Wisconsin.

She also served on two boards on behalf of State Farm, the Wisconsin Insurance Plan and the Community Insurance Information Center.

In December, 1982, Astrid joined Calvary Baptist Church where she was an active member. She served as both the Secretary and President of the American Baptist Women's Ministry and Co-Chair of the Women's Day Committee.
