Betty Powell Daniels was born on January 11, 1943 to Lucius Powell and Clara Mae Robinson Powell in Liberty, Mississippi.

Betty accepted Christ at an early age at Jerusalem Baptist Church in Liberty, Mississippi. After relocating to Milwaukee, Wisconsin, she united with Metropolitan Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of Rev. Elbert M. Kelly, Sr., Rev. Willie D. Wanzo and Rev. Brandle C. Morrow, Sr., where she was a faithful member. She was a spokesperson and traveled with the Metronome singing group. Betty received her formal education at Jerusalem School in Liberty, Mississippi and Milwaukee

Public Schools, graduating from North Division High School in January, 1961 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She received her medical training at Aurora Medical Center.

Betty was united in holy matrimony to Ronald Daniels on August 22, 1964.

She retired from Aurora at Home in January 2010.
