Booker Terry Scull, Jr. quietly slipped into peaceful and eternal rest at the age of 83 years old surrounded by and lovingly cared for by the staff of Close to Home Assisted Living in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on December 2, 2020.

He was born on July 30, 1938, in Pine Bluff, Arkansas to the late Booker Terry Scull, Sr. and Naomi Ruth Scott-Scull. Early in life he moved from the South to the Midwest and settled in Milwaukee. He also enjoyed watching a variety of TV programs, such as In Touch with Dr. Charles Stanley, Family Feud, Wheel of Fortune, Jeopardy, old Western movies, and even PBS programming, all while eating ice cream and cookies. Most of all, he loved reading, learning, teaching, and sharing God's Word. Booker loved the Lord and Savior and wanted every last person he knew, loved, and encountered, including strangers, to know and love the Lord.
