Carol so loved her seniors who were aging, she formed an elderly exercising class where they would come and sit in chairs and the exercise was mere raising their legs. It was about fellowship when it came to getting together. Carol organized outings and was very specific that it was only for the seniors. The Late Rev. E. L Thomas appointed Carol as Deaconess due to her care of her elderly father and she served in this position until her transition. Carol enjoyed being outside and in her vegetable garden, picture captivating flowers and immaculate landscaping, her love of nature was evident

Carol departed this life on Friday, January 30, 2015. She was preceded in death by her mother, Ai Rush; father, Julius Rush; husband, Enos Jones Jr., and two brothers, Earnest Rush and Russell Rush, Sr.
