Charles Worthy Hayes was born on October 28, 1935 to the union of Worthy Hayes and Mamie Willis in Mendenhall, Mississippi.

Charles received his formal education at Piney Woods Country Life in Ranking County, Mississippi.

Charles accepted Christ as his Savior at an early age.

He was employed for a Steel Mill in that late 1960's, early 1970's. In the early 1970's, he started his career as a bowler. He was known to his bowling colleagues as "Silky" but most called him "Chuck." His grandchildren and great grandchildren affectionately referred to him as "Big Daddy." In the early 1990's, he started his own business, Hayes Home Improvement. He worked up until his health began to fail.

In his leisure, he enjoyed listening to Jazz and Bowling, Bowling, Bowling. His favorite sayings were "Let's Gedder Done" and "Yeah Baby."

He was apart of several organizations which were TNBA, ABC, WIBC, and USBC. He was inducted into the Milwaukee Hall of Fame in 1993. During his bowling career, he bowled thirteen 300

games which is referred to as a perfect game, one 800 series and all were recorded after 1999. He also appeared and won Bowling With The Champs in 1974.

Charles Worthy Hayes departed this life on January 12, 2018. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Andrews Hayes; his parents Worthy Hayes and Mamie Willis; and granddaughter, Shedricka Smith.

He leaves to cherish his memory: two sons, Robert (Wanda) Hayes and Anthony Musack, three daughters, Kathy and Krystal Whitehead and Sherry Ann Hayes-Smith; eighteen grandchildren; thirty eight great grandchildren; three great great grandchildren; and a host of other loving family and friends.
