Chris father, during United States of America 'DEPRESSION era, provided food and shelter tor his family

while employed as a sharecropper and rail road installer of New Orleans, Louisiana. He relocated his family between both Louisiana and Mississippi according to seasonal crop productions. Chris and her siblings education was also seasonal when production of crop season it was mandatory all of the household participated.

November 24, 1952, the day of her eighteenth birthday, Christine left Mississippi via Grey hound Bus to

Milwaukee Wisconsin solely from word of mouth of a male neighborhood family friend. Having the "BY ANY MEANS NECESSARY" "mindset she endured many setbacks, scams, and hoodwinks in obtaining employment with Jack Pandal's Restaurant of Whitefish Bay, Wisconsin and later with St. Mary's Hospital of Milwaukee, Wisconsin from which she retired in 1996. Chris's lite truly embodied the roadmap of living lite to the fullest all while

retaining two (2) jobs. On April 11, 1955 Chris married Altamont Young in Milwaukee, WI. From this union two (2) sons were born Lester and Rory C. Young who grew up in Kingston Jamaica. On October, 1974 Chris received in her home her deceased sisters five (5) children whereby three of them graduated from Rufus King High School, Milwaukee WI.

Chris owned several homes throughout Milwaukee City limits. In 2002, Chris adopted two grand nieces and three grand nephews. she became a member of New Testament Church of Milwaukee, WI on February 27, 2002 and was active in Rock group three (3).

While at New Testament Church Chris joined the kitchen and bereavement ministries. Chris became an all encompassing full time home engineer with daily interactions of minor children schedules.

Chris transitioned peacefully amongst her loved one by her bedside at Abundant Manor,

Milwaukee WI where she had been a resident for eleven (11) years.
