True to her artistic nature, Daphany was spiritually insightful and had a gift for the profound. She had a way of seeing things many “educated” people could not fathom. She had a genuine compassion for the elderly, and fascination with different cultures from around the world. Because of her lengthy stays in residential based facilities, many did not get to know one of God’s most unique and inspiring gifts to humanity.
