CORPORAL DARREL DUWAYNE RODGERS was born to the union of Darrel and Rometa Rodgers in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on March 11, 1967. After Darrel graduated from Vincent High School in 1985, he enlisted in the United States Army in 1986, where he served as a Track Vehicle Repair Technician.

During Darrel's service in the Army, he received many awards and metals for good conduct, various other achievements and scored high on examines. He also served a tour of duty in Germany. Upon his return from Germany, Darrel was honorably discharged from the Army for a service related long term disability.

He then enrolled in Wyoming Technical Institute in Laramie, Wyoming for Automotive Collision Technology and Diesel Technician. When Darrel completed his training, he returned to Milwaukee as his service related disability was getting progressively worse and he was eventually diagnosed with schizophrenia. Darrel enjoyed fast cars and making model cars.

Corporal Darrel Duwayne Rodgers, at the age of 52, departed this life on April 3, 2019 to join God after a long battle with cancer. He was preceded in death by his grandfather, James Echols, Sr.; uncle, William Echols; and aunt, Erma Jeanne Cannon.

He leaves behind a daughter, Ashley Crabtree of Cheyenne, Wyoming and is survived by his parents, Darrel and Rometa Rodgers; grandmother, Daisy Echols; sister, Dana D. Rodgers; brother, Darron D. Rodgers; and

a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and other extended family and friends.
