He joined the United States Marine Corps (USMC) in October of 1981, where his responsibilities included conducting expeditionary and amphibious operations through combined arms, aerial and special operations forces. In October of 1987, he received an Honorable discharge from the USMC and transferred to the Marine Corps Reserve. He then spent the next 30 years working as a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) where he was dedicated to increasing the quality of life for nursing home residents. His last years were spent working for the Veterans Administration (VA).
