



## Mr. Edward Nathaniel King a.k.a. "Fella"

Edward "Fella" King was born December 21, 1962 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He was born fifth of seven children to Annie King and Reverend Huford Norwood. Fella professed a hope in Christ at an early age, was baptized and united with New Hope Missionary Baptist Church under the pastorate of the late Rev. R. L. Lathan. He later became a member of Pilgrim Rest Missionary Baptist Church in Arizona under the leadership of Bishop Alexis Thomas and was preparing to take the minister leadership training program.

Fella received his elementary education and middle school education from Milwaukee and St. Louis Public Schools respectively Milwaukee, Wisconsin and St. Louis, Missouri. Fella also attended Job Corps in St. Louis and received his GED from the Next Door Foundation in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. In 2016, he had the opportunity to be head coach of the basketball team at Sun Valley Charter School as well as an assistant coach of the Team Phoenix Amateur Athletic Union which teaches youth in preparation for college level playing.
