Efrem was a devoted son who always checked on his family even when he was suffering himself. While in the hospital and in pain he would always turn to his mother and say, "Mama, how are you? Are you okay." He was the man of the family and he and his sisters Monique and Lori shared a close bond & his love for motorcycles drew him to join the Road Rage Organization where he was fondly known as "007".

Efrem departed this life on Thursday, December 13, 2012 after a valiant attempt to heal after a motorcycle accident.
