Etta Elizabeth (Estrada) Williams, known as Betty by family and friends, was born on July 2, 1929, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, to the union of Garcia Carlos Estrada and Doris Jones. Etta was the youngest girl of eight children. She completed her education in the Milwaukee Public School System and received certifications in nursing and child care.

Etta accepted Christ as her Savior at an early age and was baptized into the Catholic faith at St. Benedict the Moor Catholic Church.

Etta Estrada was united in holy matrimony with Louis C. Williams, Sr. on August 25, 1946, in Tucson, Arizona. The union was blessed with three children.

Although Etta did not officially serve in the military, the first 12 years of her marriage were spent living on various bases as her husband, Louis served in the United States Air Force. This resulted in Etta living or traveling to Arizona, Illinois, Missouri, California, Washington and even Japan. Etta later began doing private duty nursing. In later years, she worked as a foster grandparent. Etta enjoyed sewing, cooking, playing her organ and spending time with family and friends.

Etta Elizabeth Williams departed this life on June 18, 2018. She was preceded in death by her husband Louis C.
