CLASSIC SOUTHERN BUTTERMILK PIE.....INGREDIENTS: 1 1/2 cups sugar.....3 tbsp. all-purpose flour.....3 large eggs.....1 cup buttermilk.....1/2 cup butter, melted.....1 tbsp. loosely packed lemon zest.....3 tbsp. fresh lemon juice.....1 tsp. vanilla extract.....Perfect Pastry Crust.....Garnishes: fresh berries, whipped cream, fresh mint.....How to Make It: Step 1: Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Whisk together first 2 ingredients in a large bowl. Whisk eggs and next 5 ingredients into flour mixture; Pour into Perfect Pastry Crust.....Step 2: Bake at 350 degrees for 35 to 45 minutes or until almost set, shielding edges with aluminum foil after 15 minutes. Transfer to a wire rack and cool 1 hour.
