Mother Fannie Mae Williams was born on September 16, 1942 to the union of Willie and Everlina Ransom in Fayette County, Tennessee. She received her formal education at Booker T. Washington High School in Memphis, TN. After moving to Milwaukee, Wisconsin she pursued her post high school education.

Mother Williams accepted God as the head of her life. She united with Good Samaritan Church Of God In Christ where her love for God and her love for her church resulted in a Godly life of service. As a church Mother, she had a special gift for giving guidance and wise counsel to the young women of her church. She was also the church Secretary, Sunday School Teacher, President of the Women's Department, President of the Mother's Board, District Secretary and District President of the Mother's Board. She accepted every challenge, with faith that if God called her to it, He would help her do it.

Fannie Mae was united in holy matrimony with Frank Williams on September 6, 1980 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
