I pray that on that great day of Your return Jesus that his spirit ascends.

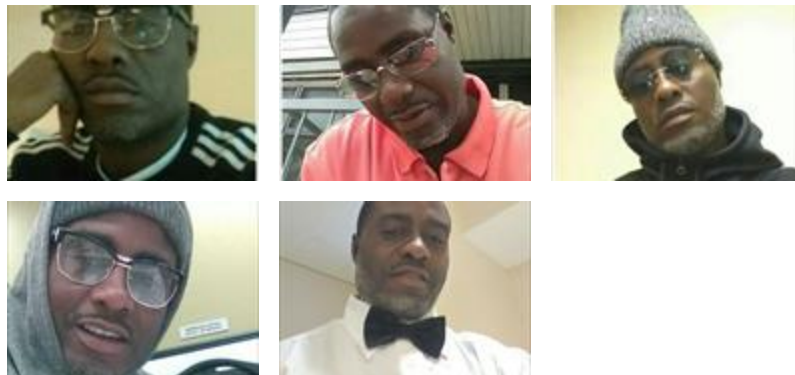
Father God I lift this prayer up to you in spirit and in truth. In Jesus Name. AMEN
