James Edward Wickliffe was born on July 20, 1950 in Hutchinson, Kansas to Paul and Dorothy (Coleman) Wickliffe. He graduated high school in 1968 and enlisted in the Navy Corps in 1969. After completing his basic training in Long Beach, California, he was assigned to the USS Higbee, where he served in Vietnam and Korea. James attained the rank of ES/052 while in the Navy and was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with 3 Bronze Stars, RVN Campaign Medal and Device, Combat Action Ribbon, and an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal (Korea).

After his release from active duty, James transferred to the Naval Reserve Manpower Center in Bainbridge, Maryland. James accepted Christ as his Savior at the age of twelve and was united with CME (Methodist) Church. He was united in holy matrimony with Darlene Bowie in Inglewood, California. Their union was blessed with four children. In his leisure, James enjoyed writing poems, reading and listening to music.

James Edward Wickliffe departed this life on February 28, 2020.
