He then started the Motorcycle Club called The Heavy Hitters in Milwaukee, WI in 2014 where he served as the President from 2014-2015 until he retired. Joseph loved hunting, fishing, and riding motorcycles. When he wasn't spending time with family or enjoying one of his hobbies, you could find him watching television. He was an avid sports fan and immensely enjoyed football, basketball, boxing, ESPN,

CNN, and we can't forget to mention a good western movie or two.
