Leo (LV) Henderson, the son of Lev and Allie D. Henderson was born September 25, 1927 in Greenwood, Mississippi. He was one of nine children. Leo (LV) received his education at Stone Street High School in Greenwood, MS. Leo (LV) accepted Christ as his Savior at an early age and was united with Mt. Aaron Baptist Church in Greenwood, MS. After moving to Milwaukee, WI in 1944, he joined Mt. Zion Baptist Church. Later in life, he became a member of Cross Lutheran Church where he served as an usher.

He enlisted in the United States Army on June 20, 1952. During the Korean War, he was a decorated war veteran having received a Bronze Star and United Nation Service Medal. He was honorably discharged on July, 14, 1954.

On May 29, 1971, Leo (LV) Henderson was united in holy matrimony with Rose Marie Henderson in Milwaukee, WI.

He was employed by United States Postal Services, Steve Mertz Construction, A.O. Smith and Scottish Cleansers with his uncle at a very early age. After his uncle retired, Leo (LV) took over the dry cleaning business. His next business venture was the opening of LV & Rose Tavern on 8th and Center and Rose's Place on 20th and Center.

In his leisure, he enjoyed riding his Harley Motorcycles as a member of the

Throttle Twisters Black Motorcycle Club. In addition, he enjoyed fishing, hunting, dancing, billiards and playing cards. He donated his time in the church and community organizations.

Leo (LV) Henderson departed this life on February 14, 2013. He was preceded in death by his wife, Rose Marie Henderson; his parents, Lev and Allie D. Henderson; his brothers, Wardell, Walter; Neil, and Jack; sisters, Allie, Mary Lois (ML), Mary Katherine (Kat), Pearlie; and grandson, Eric Bonds.
