



## Mr. Lloyd Wilson

August 13, 1947 - November 25, 2020

Lloyd Willson was the fourth son of six children born on August 13, 1947, in Humphrey, Arkansas to the union of the late Lee T. Wilson Sr. and Mary Lee Chandler Wilson. He accepted God as his personal savior at an early age. He was raised in the church by his parents where he and his siblings attended Bayou Meta Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Henderson.

During his teenage years, his family relocated to Milwaukee, Wisconsin and he graduated from North Division High School. Upon completing his high school diploma, he gained employment as a Machinist for A.O. Smith Company. He soon then accepted the call to serve in the United States Army stationed in Germany for four years. His thirst for knowledge propelled him to pursue two Associate Degrees in Paralegal Studies and Auto Mechanic at the Milwaukee Area Technical College.

To this Christian union, four children were born: Margtrinnia Willson, Maronna Willson Smith, Dr. Marica Willson Tipton, and Lloyd Willson II. His optimism and joyous spirit would light up a room and he encouraged his children to become successful in all of our academic and professional pursuits. When we experienced challenges and struggles in our life, he was always there to help us the best way he could. He often shared his auto mechanic wisdom with anyone who was willing to learn. He was affectionately called "Willsonn and was the neighborhood mechanic. On November 25, 2020 Lloyd Willson gained his wings and took his flight to Glory. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lee T. Wilson Sr. and Mary Lee Wilson; two brothers, Cephus Wilson and Lee T. Wilson, Jr.; one sister Rena Logan.
