Lois Phyllis Jones was born on August 4, 1929, to the union of Malachai Sr. and Lois Jones in Chicago, Illinois. Lois was the youngest of two children born to this union. She accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior at a young age. She later joined Pilgrim Rest Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Leroy B. Mixon.

Lois received her formal education in Memphis, TN, graduating from Woodstock High School.
