Mamie Stewart was born May 28th, 1931 in Centreville, Mississippi to Reverend George and Mary Frances Stewart. She departed this life on Saturday July 11th, 2020. Mamie acquired her education at Pleasant Grove Elementary School and received her high school Diploma from Finch High. As a young woman she met and married Lemmie Griffin. They moved to Milwaukee, Wisconsin where they realized their mutual dream of building a family, then added five children to their union. She worked faithfully at the Oerment Zablocki (VA) Medical Center in a housekeeping position and performed with such excellence that she was promoted to supervisor status. After twenty-six years of service, Mamie retired on January 24th, 1992. Mamie joined the Metropolitan Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend E.M.
