Milton Charles Perry was born on July 2, 1945, to Marion Perry Ellis and Cleveland Johnson in Humboldt, TN.

Milton graduated from Stigell High School in Humboldt, TN, where he played football. He eventually continued his education at an HBCU, Lane College, graduating in 1967 with a Bachelor's in Business Education. While studying at Lane College, he became a proud member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Incorporated. In 1971, he graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater with a Master of Science in Education.

In 1989, Milton married the love of his life, Claudette. The two blended their families and recently celebrated their 34th wedding anniversary on March 18, 2023. Their love spanned a total of 38 years together. Milton wore many titles: loving husband, devoted dad and stepdad, loyal friend, proud Alpha, and perhaps one of his most well-known titles, teacher.
