She was 1 of 11 children, Thomas, Frank, Lugene, Willie Mae, John D, MH, Helen, Mammie Lee, Johnnie Mae and Ruth. She attended Bibb County Training school in Centerville Alabama where she completed the 10th grade. She was married to Dock Moore who preceded her in death.

In 1955, she moved to Milwaukee, WI. There she joined The Tabernacle Community Baptist Church where the Late Reverend Jewel L. Williams was the pastor. She was very active in the church until her health failed her, but made sure that the family got her to church as much as possible until her death. In the early 1960's, Granny became a licensed foster mother to over 28 children of which she adopted five.

Over the years Granny participated in various Choirs and organizations such as the LaDell's Club, The Eveready Gospel Carriers, The United Ushers Choir and the Rosetta Steppers.
