She accepted Christ as her personal Savior in mid - 70's and joined the Morris Memorial Church of God in Christ under the Leadership of Pastor Garnett Herron for over a decade. She served as Youth-Ushers & Girl Scouts Leader, Sunday School Teacher, and mentor to many young people.
