



Mr. Plummer Louis Taylor III

August 15, 1948 - December 1, 2025

Plummer Louis Taylor, III was born August 15, 1948, to the union of Mary Curtis and Plummer Louis Taylor, Jr. he was their only son. When their marriage dissolved Plummer and his older sister, Lois Jean were given to the custody of their paternal grandmother Ella Vance, where they were raised in a Christian home and the nurturing of the Little Flock Missionary Baptist Church where he was baptized by Rev. F. W. Browder as a child.

Plummer graduated from Central High school in Louisville, Kentucky. Shortly after graduation he was drafted into the United States Army and was honorably discharged after his service that included the war in Vietnam. Soon after his discharged he relocated to Milwaukee. He was employed for several years at Mayflower bus company. He loved driving the bus, bribing the students with candy to behave on his route. He retired from employment with the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works.

While employed with SDC delivering food today cares he met his wife, Linda Shaw and they were joined in matrimony on June 23, 2007. They brought together their blended family. Linda's children Terrence, Terrell, Shamika, Spencer and Shayquan and his great grand nieces, Tiffany and Sandra that Plummer had raised as his own daughters.

On December 25, 2024 Plummer enter the VA Hospital after having a stroke.

With the exception of his 2025 birthday (when his condition allowed him to celebrate 4 hours from the hospital); he remained under the care of the Palliative staff on the 9th floor. On Monday, December 1, 2025 he was given his Final Salute. His name was called three times and Plummer did not answer. His service was complete, and we all are thankful that he is at peace and rest.

His parents, Mary Curtis and Plummer, Jr preceded him in death along with his grandmother Ella, his sisters Karen Coleman and Glenda Green. He leaves to cherish his memories, his wife Linda and sister Lois (Henry) Redic, of Milwaukee, WI, bonus son, Christopher Kussrow of Northern Wisconsin and the children of their blended families and their many generations, plus a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friendships.
