



## Mr. Proffessor Williams

April 28, 1929 - September 5, 2018

Proffessor Williams was born in Boulton, Mississippi on April 28, 1929 to the union of Minne Warner and Willie Williams, Sr. Professor Williams received his formal education in the Boulton School system. He accepted Christ at an early age and was united with St. Thomas Missionary Baptist Church in Boulton. He was united in holy matrimony with Bessie Mae Clemon in March 1950 in Jackson, Mississippi. Their union was blessed with seven children. Professor Williams enlisted in the US Army on, March 22, 1951. He was honorably discharged on September 10.
