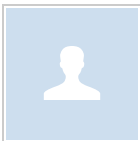
“ Hello Lavern,

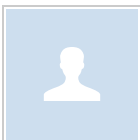


“ Lavern and family, it is with deep regret to hear of loss of your dear, darling husband, George. I'm sorry that I was unable to make it to the funeral.
