Rosa Bell Palm affectionately known as Mother, Momma Rose, Rosie, Aunt Bell, & RoBell was born on October 4, 1921, in Morton Mississippi. She was the eldest of 6 children born to George and Sephronia Gary. After the passing of her mother at the age of 12, she took on the responsibility of raising her younger siblings. Knowing this would be a difficult task she also gave her life to Christ. She was a faithful member of Mount Caramel Missionary Baptist Church.

Rosa was united in holy matrimony to Brown Palm on April 26, 1948. In December 1951, they moved to Milwaukee, Wisconsin. They had a gift for wonderful hospitality, which is why they were known as "Daddy Brown" and "Momma Rose". Family and Friends were always welcomed into their home. She was an excellent cook. Some of her signature dishes were sweet potato pies, caramel cakes, fried corn and chicken and dumplings. Their home was always a welcome haven for anyone that had a need. Momma Rose transitioned to glory on July 17, 2013. She was preceded in death

Jewel Evers-Thomas and Roosevelt Boyd, daughter Lillian Kincaid and son Rudolf Payton.
