



Mr. Squire Austin Jr.

February 13, 1946 - January 24, 2018

Squire Austin, Jr. "Barn Barn" was born on February 13, 1946 to the union of Geraldine and Square Austin in Milwaukee Wisconsin.

Squire received his formal education at Riverside High School in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Squire enlisted into the United States Air Force where he received an honorable discharge. Squire was a member of the NAACP Youth Council Commandos, who worked with Father Groppi, providing security in the 1960's Fair Housing demonstrations. He later provided security for Milwaukee Public Schools and was employed by American Motors, General Electric, Babcock & Wilcox, and retired from Johnson Controls. In his leisure, he enjoyed cribbage, backgammon, darts, cards, fishing, camping and bowling. Known for his artistic ability, Squire created many of the studded accessories worn by bikers. He loved his flashy cars and well-dressed Harley's.

Due to his leadership, camaraderie, commitment and swagger, Squire was referred to as "Sir Squire". He founded the Wolf Pack MC in 1994. As the founder, first President, and designer of the club patch, he is a lifetime member of the Wolf Pack Me. The organization now has chapters worldwide. In 2011, Squire became a member of the Sin City Deciples Me. Well known for his expertise in bringing people together and organizing events, Squire was the go to guy for processions for Home Going services to burial sites, leading those processions wearing his famed "top hat".

Squire Austin, Jr. departed this life on January 24, 2018. He leaves to

cherish his memory: mother, Geraldine Austin; sisters, Nona Davis and Claudette Austin; brothers, Dumah Saafir, Dr. Cecil Austin, and Willie "Bill" Austin; children, Richard Blake and J anay Austin; best friend, Gary; dear friend, Lee; an a host of other family and friends.
