Stacey was born to Dorothy Gray on June 1st, 1967, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He attended Bay View High school but later on completed his HSED at MATC.

Stacey accepted Christ at a young age. He has been a member of Solomon's Temple Evangelistic Ministries for over 15 years under Bishop Randolph Nichols and Pastor Nichole Nichols. He initially served as an armor bearer and later on became a deacon. He loved guiding the youth and he served as a mentor through B II S. 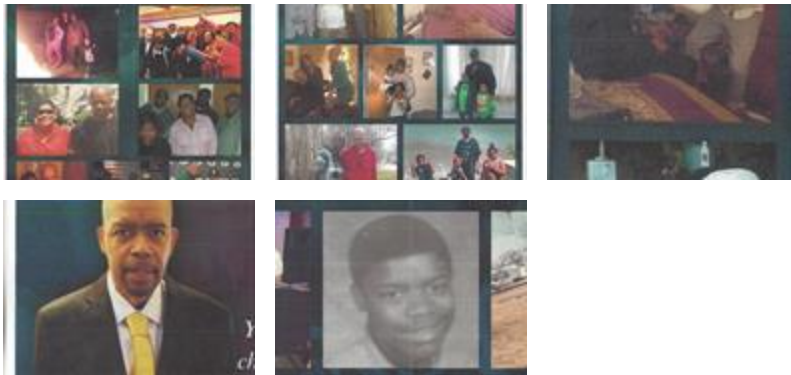
