studying the Holy Bible. He was always willing and ready for Bible discussion.

by declaring, "You're not on my level", followed by a chuckle. He was loving, giving, talented, and very intelligent. .

toward him. He was funny and enjoyed sharing laughter and memories, especially stories about

"Old times" with his family and friends. He was unconditionally loved and favored by his entire
