Deacon Steven Knox was born June 13, 1924 in St. Louis Missouri, to the union of Mr. Jesse and Deliah Knox, who preceded him in death.

In 1936, Steven enrolled in the United States Army giving diligent service to World War II until October 27, 1945, when he was honorably discharged. He served in Germany, France, and Central Europe. Steven also served as a demolition tech and he received honor for his dedicated service.

After he was discharged he moved to Columbus, Mississippi where he met LV. Tabb and they were married. This union was blessed with four sons, Steven Knox [r., Reverend Tyrone Knox, (Melissa Texas) Reverend Stanley Knox and John C. (Cecilia) Knox; three daughters, Evangelist Celestine Burrows, Yvonne Jefferson, Marcella Haywood and Irma Jones who preceded him in death.

Mr. Knox received Christ at an early age. He served as a dedicated Deacon at Calvary Missionary Baptist Church. He was a member of the Prince Hall and International A.M. F.M. Masons. He also was a member of the American Legion of Chicaao.

He leaves to mourn: seven children twenty-six grandchildren, sixty-eight great-grandchildren, twelve great-great-grandchildren, very

dear friend, Ms. Martha Davis; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives, and dear friends. Mr. Knox touched the life of many.
