Uvoyd Reynolds was born on September 16, 1935, to Willie Edward Reynolds and Lucy Neal Watkins in Princeton, Arkansas. He graduated from Langston High School in Hot Springs, Arkansas. Uvoyd accepted Christ as his Savior and was united with Visitor's Chapel AME Church.

In the 1950s, he played for the Hot Springs Bathers, a semi-professional baseball team which was part of the Arkansas-Missouri League. The Bathers featured a diverse roster, including many African American players during an era marked by segregation. Uvoyd's time with the team showcased his passion for sports and the strong bonds of teamwork that defined his character.

He dedicated many years to General Motors, where he retired after making significant contributions to the company's success. Uvoyd was a long-time member of Metropolitan Missionary Baptist Church, where he found joy singing in the choir and lifting his beautiful voice to praise and inspire others. Uvoyd's legacy of kindness, dedication, and faith will live on through his family, friends, and the many lives he touched.

Uvoyd Reynolds departed this life on October 20, 2024.
