



## Mrs. Velma Lillian Scull

March 20, 1935 - May 22, 2019

Velma Lillian (Crymes) Scull was born on March 20, 1935 to the union of James Crawford Crymes and Mary Sue Perry in Humboldt, Tennessee. Velma confessed a hope in Christ at an early age and was united with Allen Temple C.M.E., where she served as the Director of Christian Youth Fellowship. She was later connected with Sychar and Bradford Memorial A.M.E. churches.

Velma Crymes was united in holy matrimony with Booker Scull on February 24, 1982 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Velma received her formal education and graduated from Denmark High School in Denmark, Tennessee in 1954. She attended Milwaukee Area Technical College, where she was awarded certification as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) and was one of three African American graduates of the program. She worked for Milwaukee County Mental Health Complex as a LPN for 30 years. Family was the center of Velma's life and she delighted in every moment with laughing, joking and sharing stories with her family and loved ones.

A natural and gifted storyteller, Velma enjoyed movies with great stories and counted Madea films among her favorites. She loved writing and occasionally wrote skits and monologues for special church services performed

by the young people in her care as Director of Christian Youth Fellowship.

Velma Scull departed this life on May 22, 2019. Her memory will forever live in the hearts and minds of her loving family and friends. She was preceded

in death by her father, James "Bud" Crymes; mother, Mary Sue Crymes; stepmother, Lottie Crymes; brothers, M.L. Russell, Willie T. Crymes, Walker D. Crymes, and Robert L. Crymes; and sister, Mary Lou Norton.
