Warner B. Miller was born on July 27, 1930 to the union of Rev. Jessie J. Miller and Leaner Brown Miller in Waukesha, Wisconsin. He received his formal education within the Waukesha and Milwaukee Public School Systems, attending 9th Street School and Lincoln High School. At Lincoln High School, Warner participated in the Lincoln Follies where he showcased his musical talents, dancing and singing.

Warner accepted Christ at an early age at Friendship Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend B. G. Gordon. He was active in many church choirs and other gospel quartets around the city and was a member of the Quartet Union. Warner united with several churches before uniting with Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church where he served faithfully until his passing.

In September 1950, Warner enlisted into the United States Army and was honorably discharged in April 1954. Soon after leaving the army, he was employed by American Motors as a Paint Repairman for over 30 years until his retirement. In his leisure, Warner loved watching sports on TV, singing and bowling.

In 1950, Warner was united in holy matrimony with Claudette Perkins, and in 1957, he married Lillian Howard of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
