After attending elementary school, Willie graduated from Jim Hill Junior-Senior High School in the class of 1966 in Jackson, Mississippi. Willie then relocated to Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Not being one to sit still too long, Willie enlisted in the United States Army. He served during the Vietnam War from July 1966 to July 1969. After being honorably discharged,

Willie was briefly married to Judy Hudson Dunlap.

In 1972, Willie found employment at Pittsburgh Paint & Glass as a forklift driver. During this

time, Willie married Inez Martin Walker. Among life's joys for Willie were all night bid whist card

parties. These he enjoyed with family and friends.

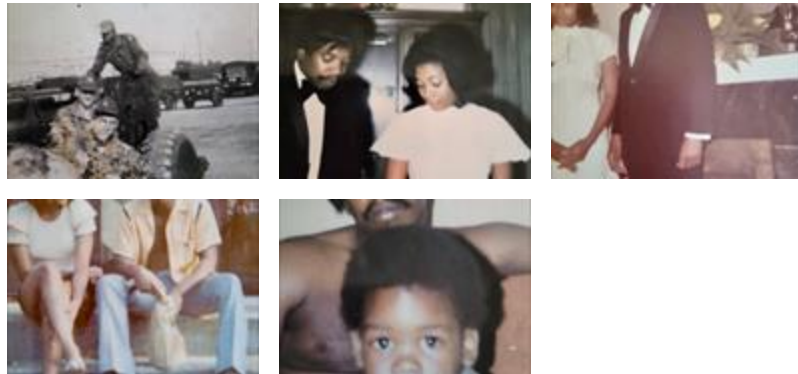

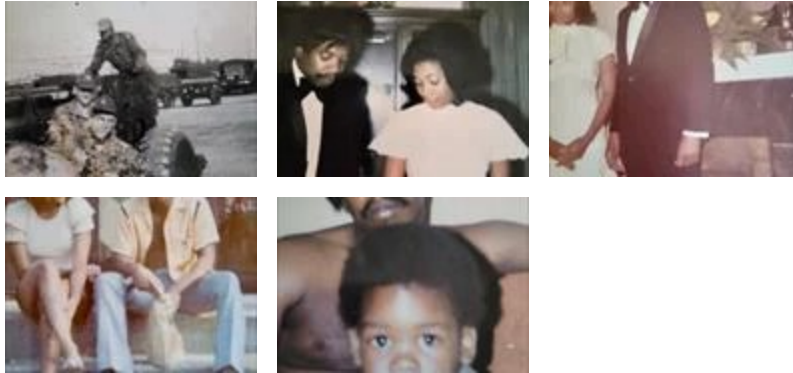
